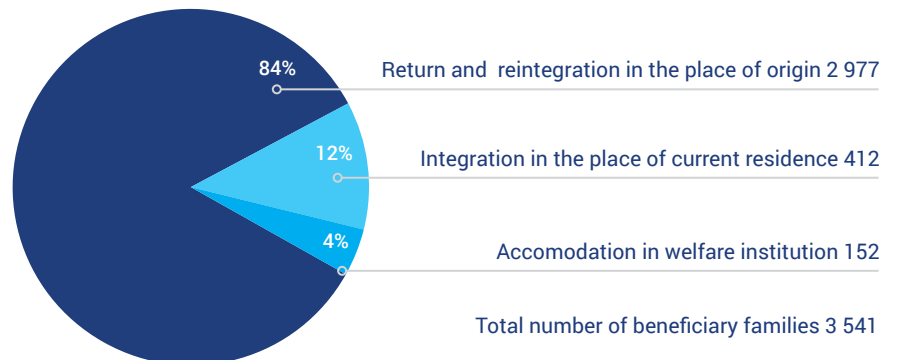

#### BACKGROUND

An estimated 550 000 people were displaced within Croatia during 1991-1992. Over the 1992-1995 period, the country received some 400 000 refugees from Bosnia and Herzegovina, of which an estimated 120 000 have since acquired Croatian citizenship. In the period from 1991 to 1995, some 250 000 minority Serbs fled Croatia. The authorities have so far registered 133 140 returnees of Serbian ethnicity to and within Croatia, representing around half of those who fled their places of origin.

#### RHP OBJECTIVES IN CROATIA

In Croatia, the RHP is expected to provide durable housing solutions to several categories of refugees, internally displaced persons (IDPs) and returnees either in their places of origin, places of displacement or within institutions of the social welfare system. In total, 3 541 households should be provided with permanent housing under the CHP Croatia.



#### LATEST ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Within the project "Purchase of 101 apartments" selected beneficiaries are former tenancy right holders or residents in collective centres. During 2015 the project has moved forward and 58 apartments have been purchased within and outside the Areas of Special State Concern. A total of 44 bought through the first public call are handed over to beneficiaries. The project is scheduled to be completed in the second half of 2016.

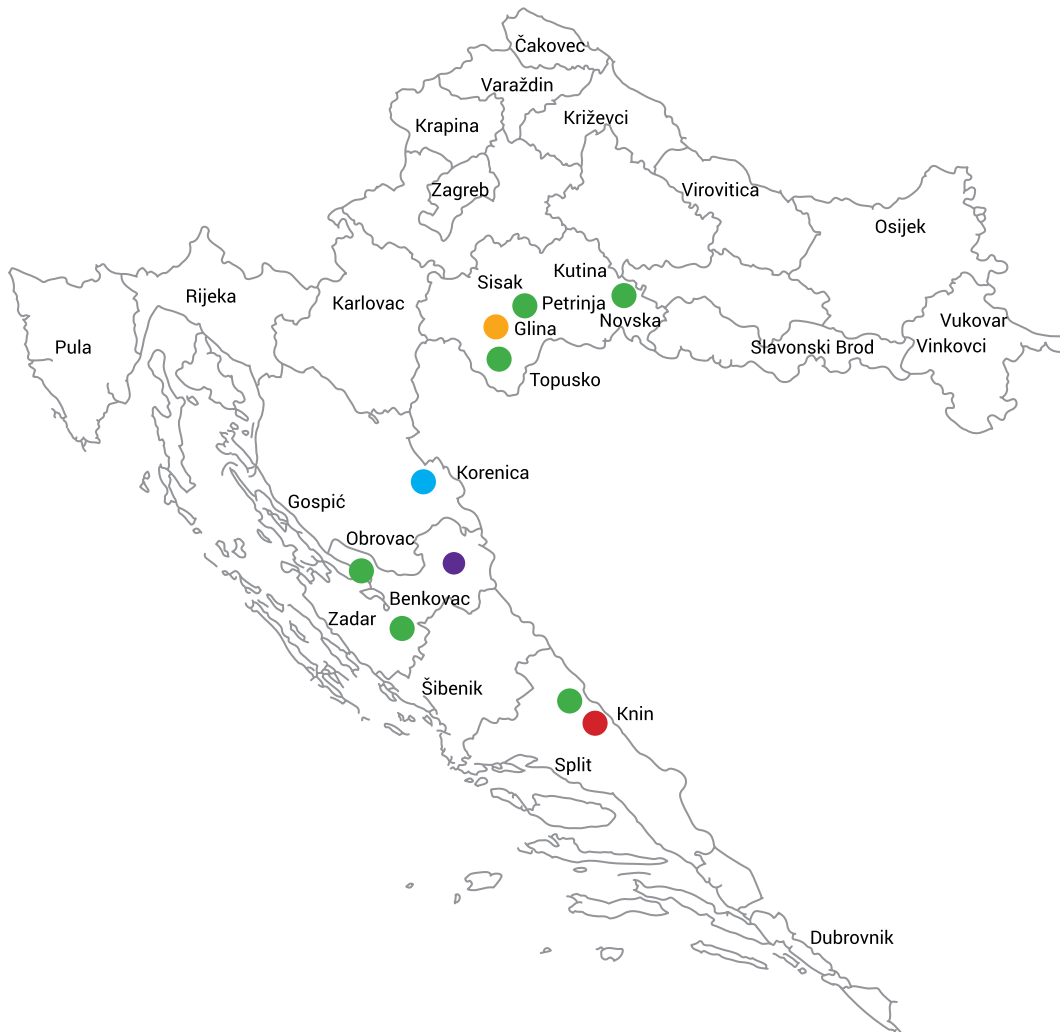

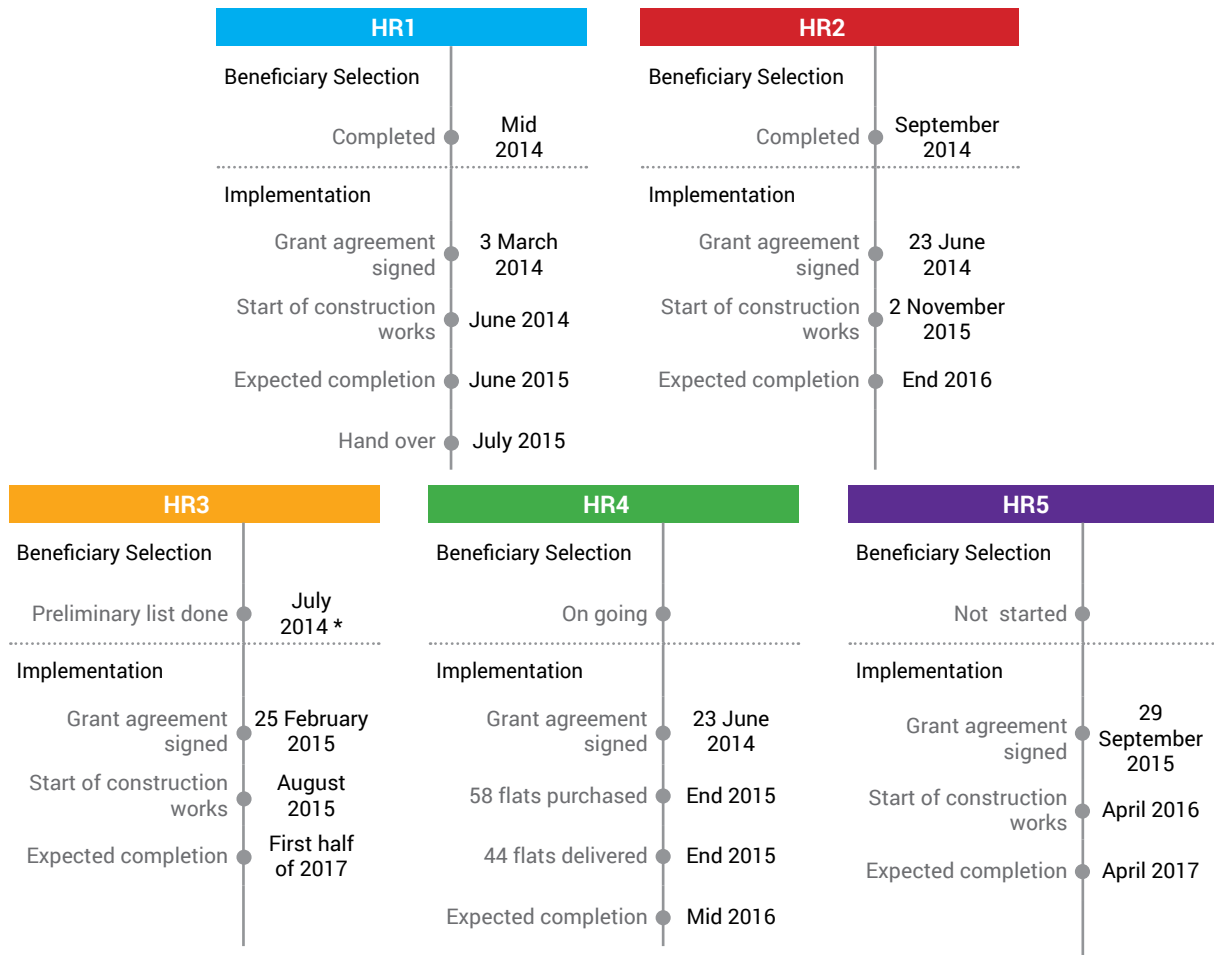

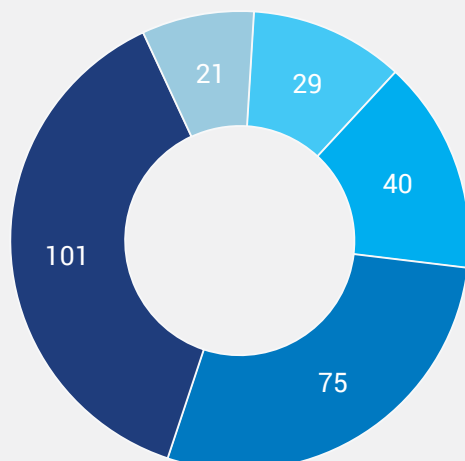
